Our Chef, Archie, has worked closely with our gardener, Paul, to create this menu, featuring the very best Yorkshire - sourced ingredients alongside produce grown right here on the grounds. Dishes highlighted in green feature ingredients cultivated here at Saltmarshe Hall.

Small Plates

- ~£8.50 Crispy nduja scotch egg, chipotle mayo (g,e)
- ~ £9.50 Slow braised beef cheek croquettes, **wild garlic aioli** (g,su,c,e,m)
- ~£7.50 Roasted red pepper houmous, warm flatbread (se,g,soy)
- ~£9 Marinated olives, fresh baked **focaccia**, balsamic olive oil (g)
- ~ £9.50 Grilled cajun chicken skewers, **tzatziki**, **estate herbs** (m)

Salads

- ~ £14.50 Grilled halloumi and **tomato** salad, couscous, roasted peppers, **soft herbs** (m,su)
- ~ £15.50 Chicken caesar, anchovy, parmesan, croutons, crispy pancetta (f,m,g,e)
- ~ £16.50 Confit duck salad, chicory, Yorkshire blue cheese, walnuts, honey vinaigrette (m,n,mu)

Large Plates

- ~ £19.50 Saltmarshe 8oz beef burger, beef fat brioche, smoked cheddar, chipotle mayo, fries (can be made vegetarian) (g,m,e)
- ~ £21.50 Grilled cajun chicken, Middle Eastern couscous, hummus, **tzatziki**, sumac onions, warm pita (also available vegan) (su, s, m, g)
- ~£15.50 Roast beef and cheddar sandwich on ciabatta, onion marmalade, **rocket**, side salad, fries (g,su,m)
- ~ £15.50 Roast pork and **apple** sandwich on ciabatta, sage stuffing, side salad, fries (g)
- ~£15 Crispy fish finger sandwich on ciabatta, tartare, gem lettuce, side salad, fries
